Today there is a renewed interest in the Historic downtowns of the Copper Basin thanks to the combined efforts of the local chambers, the Tri-Cities Business Association and the Tri-cities Revitalization Committees of Ducktown, TN Copperhill, TN, & McCaysville, GA. With the reclamation of the Copper Basin, new businesses and restaurants are sprouting up in Historic Downtown and McCaysville as people are taking a renewed interest and seeing the potential that these historic downtowns have to offer.

New business include: Little Cuba Café, Riverside Grill, Iron Bridge Café, Blue Ridge Mountain Outfitters, Threads, The Sweet Shoppe and more. Real Estate in this area has also seen an increase in the number of sales when compared to the same time last year.

In both Polk County, TN and in Fannin County, GA sales compared to the previous year have exceeded with homes sales averaging at 91% of the list price for both 2011 and 2012. Homes have not decreased in price since 2011 on average but inventory has sharply decreased to half the inventory we had this time last year in 2011.
